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Dear Vendor,

Please see accompanying Online Entry Form, Conditions of Entry and important notices regarding the 2022 Show & Sale as outlined below.

CLOSING DATE 1 APRIL 2022

- DATE: The 2022 JBS Thousand Guineas National Shorthorn Show & Sale will be held TUESDAY 14 AND WEDNESDAY 15 JUNE 2022. Scanning and Inspection will be held Monday 13 June 2022, bulls and females will be judged on Tuesday morning and sold Wednesday commencing at 10:00am.
- AGENTS: You have the choice of 2 Agents to market and sell your entries in the 2022 Show & Sale.

- OPEN CRY AUCTION: All entries will be sold via the open cry auction method.
- **RESERVE PRICE:** For bulls and females sold at the 2022 Show & Sale will be \$5,000 and \$3,000 respectively.
- **DNA TESTING:** Sire Identification is compulsory for all entries in the 2022 Show & Sale. Myostatin and Homozygous Poll status is recommended. If these are undertaken, they will be identified in the catalogue via a 'tick box'.
- **BULLS**: Entered in the 2022 Show & Sale are required to be fully vaccinated with Ultravac 7in1, Vibrovax & Pestigard. The Star Breeders Certificate is not required to be presented. All unled bulls are not to have a nose ring. No bulls to be led on the grounds without a nose ring.
- UNLED BULLS: Unled bulls are restricted to 5 entries per vendor and are subject to the same 'Conditions of Entry' as led bulls except for nose rings. Pens will be built to accommodate either 1, 2 or 3 bulls. There will also be a laneway and judging ring constructed to facilitate the movement and judging of the unled bulls.

- VET INSPECTION INCLUDING SEMEN TEST AND TESTICLE MEASUREMENT AND PALPATION: Is to be undertaken at your own expense using your Vet of choice within 30 days prior to the Sale. Please ask your Vet to complete the '2022 Cattle Examination Report'. This is to be provided to the Committee prior to Scanning and Inspection at the Dubbo Showgrounds Monday 13 June 2022.
- **RINGWORM:** Animals will be ineligible for exhibition or sale unless there is at least 5mm of hair growth on the ringworm site Monday 13 June 2022.
- **MEDICATION:** Any antibiotics or anti-inflammatory administered by vaccination within 14 days prior to inspection on 13 June 2022 be reported to the Committee via the '2022 Treatment Schedule Form' supplied. This is to be provided to the Committee prior to Scanning and Inspection at the Dubbo Showgrounds Monday 13 June 2022.
- **FEMALE SHOW & SALE:** The 2022 Show & Sale will again see the inclusion of a Special Female Sale. This year females will also be judged. The age limit for females will be between 8 months and 6 years.
- Females are required to be assessed for structural soundness by your vet.
- **GENETIC PACKAGES:** The 2022 Show & Sale will see the offering of genetic package entries available to vendors who has supported the previous two sales. Entries can be in the form of:
 - a. The sale of an embryo flush consisting of at least 5 freezable embryos being A Grade or B Grade. The flush must be completed within 12 months of the Show & Sale. All associated costs are the responsibility of the purchaser. To be sold per package.
 - b. The sale of **embryo packages** collected prior to the Show and Sale with each package consisting of a minimum of 5 frozen embryos being A Grade or B Grade. To be sold per package.
 - c. The sale of semen packages collected prior to the Show and Sale. Must be of Commercial Standard. offered in lots of either 5, 10 or 20 straws. To be sold per straw.

The collection of embryos and semen MUST be performed by an **accredited Technician**. Documentation supporting this is the responsibility of the vendor.

- NO REFUNDS will be given for bulls, females or genetics packages withdrawn from sale after 1 June 2022. Entries withdrawn prior to 22 April 2022 will receive a full refund. Entries withdrawn from 23 April to 1 June 2022 will receive a partial refund of \$150.
- COPY OF CERTIFICATE OF CURRENCY FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE must have the clause "Situation: Anywhere in Australia" and accompany the online entry.
- Parader's at the 2022 JBS Thousand Guineas National Shorthorn Show & Sale will wear ROYAL BLUE woollen vests in the Show ring. Vendors may however wear appropriate stud identification after the completion of Judging.
- Animal entered in the 2022 Show & Sale must be of suitable temperament and taught to lead prior to the event.
- No 3rd party advertising is permitted throughout the Show & Sale without Committee approval.

JUDGING FORMAT - LED BULLS

- 2 Divisions.
- Champion and Reserve in each Division.
- Grand Champion selected from Division Champions.

LAMBELL MACKINNON TROPHY

- The Lambell MacKinnon Trophy is a breeder's group of 3 bulls, from the same vendor, to be judged as a Breeders Group at the completion of the normal judging.
- Additional Entry Fee of \$110 (including GST) per entry is payable for entry into this class
- You do not need to nominate which 3 bulls you will enter in this class beforehand.
- A perpetual trophy along with a smaller trophy for the winner have been kindly donated by the Lambell and MacKinnon Families.
- Cash Jackpot prize money will be split 2/3 to the winner, 2/3 of remaining 1/3 for 2nd place and remainder for 3rd place.

JOHN HORNE MEMORIAL TROPHY

The John Horne Memorial Trophy was introduced in 2015 and is awarded to the vendor of the Highest Priced Bull sold at Auction.

JOHN ARMSTRONG TROPHY

Will be awarded to the most Successful Exhibitor in the show ring. The trophy is in recognition of John's outstanding 50 years continuous service to the Committee.

SALE ORDER OF BULLS FOR CATALOGUES

The Catalogue will be divided into two age groups being Divisions 1 & 2. These two groups alternate the position in the catalogue yearly.

In 2022 Division 1 bulls will be sold first followed by Division 2. The bulls will be sold Oldest to Youngest in Both Divisions 1 & 2.

The Agents position or order will be determined by a coin toss after the closing date of entries. To determine the catalogue position within each group the following points apply.

- The vendor's oldest bull will determine the position.
- Where a vendor has up to 4 bulls, they will be catalogued together (in the order the vendor chooses).
- If a vendor has 5 bulls, the oldest would determine the position, but the vendor would nominate which bulls to catalogue with him, up to a maximum of 4 in a row. The oldest of the remaining bulls would determine the position for them in that catalogue section.
- Where there is more than one bull with the same DOB then alphabetical order of vendor will separate them.
- Any vendor who has a run of bulls drawn in Lot 1 to Lot 10 in the catalogue has the right to elect to sell one bull (the oldest) only. That vendor's next position will be determined by their next oldest bull. Note: this only applies to the first catalogue group.
- The exhibitors/vendors of the Grand Champion Bull has the right to sell him at the front of their respective catalogue sections and bring his team with him.

CATALOGUE

- Cut off date for inclusion in the **April International Genetics Solutions (IGS) EPD** run and inclusion of those figures in the catalogue is 1 April 2022.
- Written comments on each lot will be limited to 25 words or less. Comments must not include the likes of Fully Vaccinated, Semen Tested or DNA Sire verified as these are conditions of entry.
- Vendor's are entitled to submit **one photograph** for each entry in the 2022 Show & Sale which will be printed in the catalogue.
- All photographs and videos MUST be provided by Friday 22 April 2022. Photographs
 and videos are to be submitted to via email to imagesshorthornbullsale@gmail.com
 with the preferred file type being .jpeg and MPEG-4 respectively. It is requested that
 each photo and video be saved with the naming convention Vendor Name_ Exhibit
 Tattoo.

PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES

- Payment of entries MUST be received by the closing date of entries being 1 April 2022.
